Sabbatical Policy

- Principles
 - Sabbatical is NOT an entitlement
 - Sabbatical is to enhance the faculty capabilities in research
- Criteria in deciding on sabbatical applications
 - Research track record and potential
 - Teaching and other administrative needs of the Department/School
 - Frequency of sabbatical leaves/duration since last sabbatical
- Criteria in deciding on make-up of teaching
 - Default is full teaching make-up
 - Discretion of DH in consultation with the Dean based on
 - Frequency of sabbatical leaves/duration since last sabbatical
 - Teaching and other administrative needs of the Department/School

Guideline for Academic Staff who are not DH/DIPO/Dean

Duration Since Last Sabbatical Leave (Joining HKUST) (Years)	Reduction of Normal Teaching Load
6-7	Zero
8-9	1/3
10-11	2/3
12 or above	All

Guideline for DH/DIPO/Dean

Duration of the Term	Reduction of Normal Teaching Load
<= 3 Years	2/3
> 3 Years	All

For those who can be assessed using both guideline, the largest reduction takes priority
