- 2. As some students(or maybe most of them) have basic relative ideas in their high school, while some do not, like me, it is too fast and very hard to follow. Also, I think more time should be spent on the lesson materials(PPT/textbook/theory/...), instead of the assignment answer. Sometime, using almost 1 hour to talk about the answer and 20 minutes for the lesson materials means fewer time for teaching on the materials. It makes us hard to follow and catch up the ideas too.
- 3. I hope more time is given to this course as the content are very interesting but a bit rushy. I hope more examples in real life can be given such as analysing the CPI, PCE and find thr correlations with the stock and bond markets.
- 4. Introduced many concepts in Macroeconomics, the content is cumulative and abundant. I hope my grades is fine~
- 5. The instructor's teaching is extremely boring. Besides, it is not friendly to students who have not studied economics in secondary school.
- 6. The news that Prof provide is interesting and help student to develop the critical thinking skills. However, I think it is a bit confusing to me that the lecture are using both slide and visualizer, as they have different flow, but it is not a big problem.
- 7. The professor's teaching is good enough, however, the course content is too deep and packed for students without an economic background
- 8. Topics sometimes goes very fast, it is kind of too much for student who know nothing about economics. Also, all the cases in the course are based on US, which make things more confusing as the US system and style are so different from the local one.
